Production: "Dead to the Last Drop" Had a lot of people interested in tryouts but only three people showed up. Have lots of help for tech and set. Brandon is directing with T.J. Assistant director. Still working on getting a cast and Brandon will let the board know in a week if play is cancelled or still on. Need to get better advertising for plays. The price of the fire hall is "the same as last time" according to the contact. The rights to the play have been purchased with ability to have refunded if cancelled.

The minutes from last meeting have an error which secretary must fix before approval.

Financial: general account remains the same at \$316.19. Production account balance after all expenditures= \$2356.23

Expenditures: check to Brandon cleared, deposit of \$90 and \$ 50 cleared, pay pal payed Facebook \$15.00 for advertising, "The Bob and Al Show"=\$1046.49 in total receipts, \$736.00 in total expenditures total profit=\$310.49. After auditions advertising for Facebook runs will take \$15 out.

Lights= From last show=Spot light with moving head \$63.59; controller for LED \$9.32; DMX end cap and cables 8 pack \$31.78 This show: two more moving head wash lights and three clamps \$174.47 total for all lights \$356.53

Rights for this show \$140.00 can cancel and get money back if need be. Check written for Brandon for \$496.53 for lights and rights for show.

Work Shops: Frank will check with N4C's to see if able to host work shops sometime in spring or summer. Possibility of improvisation workshops, outline of productions workshops, all with hopes of expanding the group. Midweek day agreed upon for workshops. Frank will update at next meeting.
