Motion to have ads in the Press Enterprise not to exceed \$200.00 made by Carl and seconded by Karen. Motion approved. We are going to contact earlier to get the write up in sooner.

We need to get at least \$200.00 in pain and sets approved by the next meeting.

The presales for the play have opened on Friday and we are already at 32% sold.

Scott Roper has gone through all of M.R.'s old scripts and stuff and contacted Brandon. There's a whole box full of stuff. We are going to put a thank you in the program for the donations.

Brandon will update the website as needed. The Vo-Tech has approved the menu and will feed the cast.

Karen will video the play. We are going to have a more direct way of scoring the guesses and possibly have free tickets for a prize. More at the next meeting.
