

Fishing Creek Players Board of Directors meeting April 11, 2023

No one was absent. Members of the cast of "Alibis" present during meeting due to practice following meeting.

Meeting came to order at 6:06. Motion to approve February and March meeting minutes made by Carl and seconded by Brandon. Motion approved.

Financial=Production account=\$10,233.48 General account=\$1957.44 CD=\$5043.76 interest=\$12.76 total of all accounts minus CD=\$12,190.92

So far we have had \$8,192.00 in ticket sales, \$50.00 craft fair donations and \$90.00 in ad sales.

Checks were made out to Karen for \$260.39 for paint, supplies, curtains, couch etc. and Brandon for payment of the Press Enterprise ad and play rights in the amount of \$62.69. A check was made out to Brandon for tickets for the play so he cashed it for \$184.00. The total amount owed was \$246.69. We paid the balance. Please make note of 6 seats sold for show.

Pay pal report=once the show is done we will have \$197.76 that people have paid for credit card fees

Raise the Region= total of \$809.52 we initially had \$740.00 in donations with an added bonus of \$86.92

We are discussing purchasing a camera and possibly an iPad for the next play. Frank has invited the cast and fellow board members to his July 1 party. We are discussing possibly going to a show or a picnic as the cast. We will discuss more at the next meeting.

There are only 3 tickets left to Alibis! Get them while you can!

Next production=First and second weekend in November. Brandon will speak to Vo-Tech and Danielle and see if we can add on an additional day and if that Vo-Tech is interested in add on options for the menus. Thursdays are the only days we can add on. We will discuss the possibility of raising prices at the next meeting. There has been an interest by the board of possibly speaking to the owners of the Benton Presbyterian Church to see if we can use the building as a venue and store our supplies there. Brandon will speak to the owners and report at the next meeting. Karen has offered to help fill out grant applications to help lease arrangements if need be.
