Kids play at N4C- Motion to approve payments of all costumes totaling \$120.00 made by Brandon and seconded by Marilyn. Motion approved. Payments are as follows= \$19.99 for Dairy farmer shirt check made out to Carl Kishbaugh; \$41.97 for cow shirts check made out to Cassie Chapin, \$66.70 for dog and donkey shirts, donkey ears and narrator shirt check made out to Liane Hayman.

Joey Sue is willing to make flower arrangements for the fall show and then we can have arrangements for both spring and fall shows from now on. The spring arrangements are at her house and she can store all arrangements there. She found jars already with burlap decorations and purchased fall flowers. Total of purchases is \$48.48. Caterers= Brandon did stop by The Old Filling Station and drop off the results of the survey for Megan but has not had a chance to talk to her yet. In the meantime he has spoken to Fought's catering and 2 ½ Street Eats and both are on board to cater if need be.

Karen spoke to Joe Edmundon at Columbia Montour Vo-Tech School and the culinary class is more than willing to cater and he will incorporate it in to their lesson plans. With doing the catering they can raise money to compete in culinary competitions. He stated they can make it a theme that goes along with the play and they are on board to cater more plays in the future. Classes start next week.

BYOB is not a problem. This would be a great opportunity for us to partner with Vo-tech and Brandon and Karen will speak to Joe Edmondson before the next meeting and report back at the next meeting.

We need to pick out a play and have auditions by the next meeting. Ticket prices will be decided at the next meeting with the general thought being in the \$30-\$32 range being the last show was \$28 per ticket. The general opinion of the survey stated the ticket prices can be raised as long as the food is good. We are also considering purchasing a whole table for "X" amount of dollars but we aren't sure if that will work due to single customers being separated. We will discuss more at the next meeting.
